

# Community Service Program

## Student Participation

Beginning with the graduating class of 2006, all students will be required to perform 30 hours of community service (20 hours for the class of 2005). A student may perform all 30 hours in a single year.

## Examples of Appropriate Student Activities

- Perform public relations tasks
- Help with child care
- Participate in special events
- Tutor children or adults
- Improve the environment
- Organize/assist with recreation programs
- Visit the homebound
- Provide special skills/talents
- Guide visitors
- Assist the elderly
- Collect and distribute food, toys and specialties

Students may perform community service after school, on weekends, during vacations, etc. **Please note that community service hours performed during the school day, to fulfill a requirement for another organization, or imposed by the courts will not count toward a student's graduation requirement.**

**As per Board of Education policy #5123, any student who does not perform the required number of community service hours will not be permitted to participate in the high school graduation ceremony.**
