IMPORTANT ITEMS FOR THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

- New! Middle School Entrance- Door # 15 (see Handbook and Email from Mr. D'Amico for more information):
- ➤ MS Spanish is a new course for all Junior Aviators;
- All students will have full access to Chromebooks during instructional time;
- Continuation of the *Link It* benchmark program, which is used to assess and analyze student mastery of state standards;
- > <u>SchoolWide New Language Arts program to be utilized in ELA courses;</u>
- ➤ Clubs and Field Trips (including Overnight) will be back for the 2022-23 School Year!
- New Floors in Cafeteria, Media Center, and Weight Room!



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- New/ Renewed educational platforms, including but not limited to: Google Apps for Education, ScreenCastify, Go Math, Khan Academy, NewsELA, IXL, Ed Puzzle, TCI, FlipGrid, Sora, Jamboard, Padlet, Go Guardian, Edulastic, and Quaver Music.
- ➤ Continuation of a positive school climate! → In addition to our *Character Education Day* in October 12th and our regular Junior Aviator Class Assemblies, all students will have an opportunity to participate in our character-education program: students can earn a Character MVP Card from a teacher, administrator, or support staff member anytime they are **caught in the act of doing something good!**
- ➤ Covid-19: As we have done throughout the pandemic, we will be communicating regularly with our students, parents, and community members in regard to updated guidance, protocols, and procedures to be implemented in our school regarding Covid-19. Furthermore, students should **NOT** report to the school building if they are exhibiting the following:
 - ✓ <u>Two (2) or more of the following symptoms:</u> chills, rigors (shivers), myalgia (muscle aches), headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion, runny nose;
 - <u>O</u>
 - ✓ One (1) or more of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new olfactory disorder, fever, or new taste disorder.
 - Chromebooks: All Junior Aviator students are expected to bring their school-issued Chromebook to school (fully charged) on September 7th. At the beginning of this year, all Middle School students will receive a brand new Chromebook. If you are having any issues with your Chromebook, or any of your school accounts, please do not hesitate to call our **Tech Department at (201) 639-6911** for assistance.
 - ✓ <u>Incoming 6th grade Junior Aviators-</u> simply bring your Chromebook from Euclid or Lincoln with you on September 7th (fully charged). Please do not worry at all! You are in great hands and your teachers will walk you through everything that you need to know.
 - Lunch: We are very happy to be able to have our normal lunch setup back at our school! Students may bring in their own brown-bag lunch from home <u>OR</u> pay for a school lunch from Maschio's at school.
 - ➤ <u>Lockers:</u> MS students will be assigned a school locker for the 2022-2023 school year. However, students will ONLY be permitted to visit their locker during the following designated times:
 - ✓ Upon arrival prior to Period 1
 - ✓ Lunchtime (mid-day)
 - ✓ At dismissal following period 8

*Backpacks may be brought to and from school, but students will not be able to have them during the school day. Drawstring bags ONLY will be permitted in the classrooms, hallways, etc.

MIDDLE SCHOOL ENTRANCE

- NEW! The Middle School Entrance has been re-located from its previous location (formerly Door # 12 near Tennis Courts). The MS Entrance will now be located at **Door # 15**, which is physically located at the corner of Paterson Avenue and the Boulevard.
- > Some very important items to know regarding the NEW Middle School Entrance:
 - ✓ This is a STUDENT ENTRANCE ONLY. All Visitors, Guests, Parents, and Guardians will need to report to Door # 1 located on the Boulevard (Main Entrance) for early student pick-ups, meetings with school staff, dropping off lunches/school items at ANY time during the school day.
 - ✓ A Visitor Monitor will be available at <u>Door # 1</u> each school day to assist you upon your arrival. The hours of operation are 7:15am-3:15pm Monday through Friday during the school year.
 - ✓ MS Students are expected to use the MS Entrance (Door # 15) to enter the school building each school day any time after 7:25am. Students should <u>NOT</u> arrive any earlier than 7:25am as there will be no supervision for the students.
 - ✓ <u>IMPORTANT:</u> Students who are tardy to school after 9am must report to Door # 1 (Main Entrance) as the MS Entrance will be closed after 9am.

Common Assessments will be tracked on Google Sheets.

- 2) *LinkIt* Benchmark Assessment (ELA and Mathematics)
- 3) Data Sheets including Math *IXL*, Science IXL, Social Studies Writing, Language Arts, Writing and Basic Skills Growth.
- 4) SGO's with standards and student grouping/results
- 5) Lesson plans weekly in Google Teacher Folders

<u>Goal #2</u> - The Middle School will be focused on student growth in all content areas with a strong focus on ELA and Mathematics.

- 1) Student Growth measured by LinkIt, SchoolWide, IXL, and Go Math
- 2) Continued Implementation of *SchoolWide* and *IXL* to all students
- 3) Restructuring of ELA and Math Courses aligned with curriculum
- 4) Continued Planning with Grade Level and Department (vertical and horizontal articulation)
