Our annual Field Day event will take place on Thursday, June 6th, 2024, at Depken Athletic Field (Rain Date-- Monday, June 10th). All Middle School students will report directly to Depken Field no later than 7:55am (no earlier than 7:35 am please). Daily Attendance will be taken promptly at 7:55am, just like any other school day. ALL STUDENTS should be sitting in the bleachers with their homeroom teacher. Field Day will be a single-session day and students will be dismissed from Depken Field at 12:00pm.

Students will participate in a number of physical activity challenges/ activities, including but not limited to: Field Goal Kick, Accuracy Throws, Long-Jump competitions, Four-Square games, and a series of Relay Races. This applies to any T-shirt that is worn by a student for Field Day, whether it was purchased through the school or not.
