

Interesting Facts About Bats



1 Bats are interesting animals. Like most mammals, they are not all alike. Some are different colors. Some are different sizes. They also eat different things. You may already know some things about bats. You might be surprised to learn something new.

Where They Live

Bats can live almost anywhere in the world. Their ability to fly helps them to live in many places. They need a place to sleep during the day. They need a place to find <u>food</u>. Their habitat is the place where they live. It needs to be a place where they can <u>hibernate</u> in the winter. Hibernate means to sleep through the winter.

What They Eat

Most bats eat insects. Some bats eat fruit. Some eat pollen from flowers. Some eat fish, frogs, or small mammals. Some bats even eat blood from other animals.

Their Body Parts

4 Have you heard the saying, "as blind as a bat?" Well, bats are not actually blind. They can see, but their eyes are <u>small</u> and poorly developed. Bats have a <u>good</u> sense of hearing and smell. Most bats have sharp teeth. They use their teeth to eat insects or fruit. Bats have wings. Their wings are thinner than the wings on birds.

Other Facts about Bats

There are over 1000 different species of bats. Bats are nocturnal, which means they sleep during the day. They are active at night. Bats have a special ability to "see" at night. It is called echolocation. The bat makes a noise. The noise bounces off things and the bat can tell if there is something in its path. Bats can live over 20 years.

Keeping Bats Safe

help protect bats and keep them safe. Tell others not to touch bats in the wild. You can also tell others that bats are helpful. They eat insects. They spread seeds and pollen. Also, the saliva from vampire bats is being used in research for heart diseases.
