

BOOK SWAP

Does your child have a pile of books sitting in their room that they have already read? Do you wish you had an opportunity to exchange them for more exciting reading materials? Then... This Book Swap is for YOU!

How It Works

From March 4th to March 15th, students may bring in any “gently used” books to their homeroom teacher for donation. We will track the number of books that each child donates. The maximum number of books a student may bring in is 5. We will not be able to accept any books after March 15th.

On March 19th at Achievement Night, from 6:30 to 7:30, the students may come to the designated spot at Lincoln School (accompanied by an adult) and select any ‘gently used’ books of their choice based on the number of books that they donated. For example, if you donated 3 books during our donation period, you may select 3 books to take home that night, if you donated 5 books, then you may select 5 books, etc.

Book Criteria

Please make choices carefully before bringing in books. Books will only be accepted under the following guidelines:

- Books must be appropriate for grades Kindergarten-Fifth grade only.
- Books must be in gently used condition: cover on, no rips, tears, or bent edges.
- Books with coloring or writing in them will NOT be accepted.
- Coloring books, activity books, and sticker books will NOT be accepted.
- Books from kids’ meals will NOT be accepted (Chick-fil-a, McDonald’s, etc.)
- Books with sound or that need batteries will NOT be accepted.

Please note that the selection of books available will be based on books donated. We cannot ensure specific titles, etc. There will be no returns or exchanges on books. If you do not attend Achievement Night, there will be no other chance to swap your books.
