

COVID-19 exclusion (isolation) criteria for individuals who test positive for COVID-19:

- If a student has COVID-like symptoms, they should be tested for Covid-19.
- Stay home for at least 5 full days after a positive COVID test. Day Zero is the day of the positive test. Day 1 is the next day.
- If the student has no symptoms or symptoms resolve after 5 days and the student is fever-free (without the use of fever-reducing medication) for 24 hours, the student can return to school **and** must **wear a mask days 6-10**.
- If the student is unable to wear a mask in school days 6-10, the student should stay home from school and may return on Day 11.

For all COVID exposures, it is recommended that the exposed person wear a mask in school and at all indoor activities for 10 days.

- The student should wear their mask from day 0 through day 10.
 - Day 0 is the day of the student's last exposure to someone with COVID-19.
 - Day 1 is the first full day after the student's last exposure.
