3. **Slide 2:** Write 2-3 sentences about the location of the country. Add a picture showing the geographic location of the country. Add 1-2 words in French and show their translation, for example north=nord
4. **Slide 3:** Tell what the capital of the country is and list major cities in the country. Add 2-4 pictures to this slide.
5. **Slide 4:** Write 2-3 sentences about the population of the country. What are the most populated areas and why? Add 2-4 pictures to this slide. Add 1-2 words in French and show their translation, for example north=nord
6. **Slide 5:** Daily activities: What are some things that people do in this country? What are some customs/traditions? What do people do in their free time? Add 2-4 pictures. Add 1-2 words in French and show their translation, for example north=nord
7. **Slide 6:** Ethnic Make-up: What groups of people make up this country? Is it a diverse place? What ethnicity are most people? Add 2-4 pictures to this slide. Add 1-2 words in French and show their translation, for example north=nord
8. **Slide 7:** Write a paragraph about the history of this country. Add 2-4 pictures to this slide. Add 1-2 words in French and show their translation, for example north=nord
9. **Slide 8:** Government: What type of government does this country have? Who are the leaders of this country? Add 2-4 pictures to this slide. Add 1-2 words in French and show their translation, for example north=nord
10. **Slide 9:** Economy: Describe the wealth and resources of this country. What does this

country produce? What are the main sources of revenue? Add 2-4 pictures to this slide.
