## District Goals 2024-2025

1. *Improve K-12 mathematics student achievement* by fully integrating the SAVVAS enVision K-8, Algebra, Geometry, and Algebra II textbooks as the primary resources aligned with the NJSLS-M. Ensure all mathematics teachers receive comprehensive training and conduct regular classroom observations to maintain program fidelity and rigor, aiming to increase students meeting or exceeding grade-level standards on state assessments by June 2025.

2. <u>Enhance K-12 English Language Arts</u> by systematically monitoring students' progress in Reading, Print Concepts, Phonological Awareness, and Phonics and Word Identification across all grade levels. Utilize assessment data to inform instruction and provide targeted interventions, ensuring all students receive the support needed to achieve grade-level proficiency. Build an understanding of the Science of Reading and implement instructional strategies and methods to improve student achievement.

3. *Enhance inclusionary practices within special education classrooms*. Research consistently shows that students with disabilities benefit from inclusive education settings, where they can interact with their peers and participate in the same curriculum, provided they receive the necessary support. Inclusion promotes social interaction, reduces stigmatization, and helps students with disabilities develop a stronger sense of belonging and self-worth.

4. <u>Use instructional technology to support content area mastery and student growth</u> by integrating digital tools and resources into daily teaching practices. Provide professional development for staff and students on effectively and responsibly utilizing AI, ensuring technology use enhances learning outcomes and prepares students for future challenges.
