The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) has <u>released the 2023-2024 School Performance</u> <u>Reports</u>, now available at www.njschooldata.org. These reports provide valuable insights into school and district performance, supporting efforts to ensure all students have equitable access to high-quality education.

The NJDOE encourages school communities to use these reports, along with local data, to identify priorities, address gaps, and guide planning for the upcoming year, including the allocation of state and federal resources.

What's New in the 2023-2024 Reports

This year's reports include updates based on stakeholder feedback and policy changes, including:

- Chronic Absenteeism Trends: Three-year data trends, expanded absence summaries, and schoolwide corrective action plan requirements.
- Seal of Biliteracy Recognition: Information on multilingual learners earning the Seal of Biliteracy.
- Expanded Arts Participation Data: Visual and performing arts participation data now includes grades K-12.
- **Disciplinary and Law Enforcement Data**: Reports now display student disciplinary removals, police notifications, and arrests by student group and grade level.
- **High School Persistence & Graduation Rates**: New six-year federal graduation rates aligned with proposed ESSA amendments.
