Dear Parents/Guardians

Please be aware that there is one case of reported Coxsackie Virus in Euclid School. One student has reported Coxsackie Virus, and several students have had symptoms related to the virus. The reported case started with a rash or blister-like papules on the skin. The rash usually occurs on the face, mouth, hands or feet. Often children will develop fever, headache and flu-like symptoms within 5 days of catching the virus & prior to developing the rash.

At this time we want to make you aware of the presence of the virus and ask you to keep your child home if he/she reports the symptoms as stated above. Please continue to encourage good handwashing as well as sharing an awareness of how contagious this virus can be.
