The Hasbrouck Heights Music Parents Association will be awarding scholarships to qualified music students. The purpose of these scholarships is to recognize outstanding efforts and achievements as well as to offer financial assistance for continuing education after high school. These scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Assembly in June.

ELIGIBILITY: The student and parent/guardian must be a member in good standing for a minimum of three (3) years.

GOOD STANDING

1. Memberships dues paid for three (3) consecutive years.
2. Students must participate in one (1) fundraiser and competition (if applicable) for three (3) consecutive years.
3. Parent/guardian must be an active part of volunteering during a three (3) year time period. (helping with band camp lunches/snacks, chaperoning can shakes, car washes/pizza parties, selling 50/50's at concerts).

All applications will be reviewed and considered by a scholarship committee appointed by the Music Parents Association President. All information will be kept confidential. Parents of applicants cannot serve on the committee. The Association reserves the right to amend any of the above and will take all factors into consideration and will decide the order of priority when faced with several candidates. The number of scholarships will depend on the amount of money the Association has set aside that year. The Music Program directors are not involved with choosing the scholarship candidates.

Directions for students:

1. Students must completely fill out the scholarship and include an essay (150 word minimum) explaining how music has enhanced their life.
2. Student must be in the 12th grade, graduating in June with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and continuing their education at an accredited college or vocational school.
